

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The minimum qualifications / eligibility criteria for admission to the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) program is as given below:

Program	Minimum Eligibility Criteria
B.Pharm	<p>a) Candidates must have appeared in JEE (Main) 2021 or National Eligibility cum Entrance Test 2021 (NEET-UG)</p> <p>b) Candidates must have passed Class 12 / I.Sc. or equivalent qualifying examination.</p> <p>c) Candidates must have passed in English, Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics / Biology in Class 12 / I.Sc. or Equivalent Qualifying Examination with minimum 50% marks (45% for SC/ST/PwD).</p> <p>d) Marks in Class 12 to be computed as average of following 4 subjects - English, Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics / Biology.</p>

Notes:

1. Only those candidates whose date of birth falls on or after 1st October 1996 in case of General / OBC category and 1st October 1991 in case of SC/ST/PwD are eligible for admission. Date of Birth as recorded in the Secondary Education Board Class X (High School) certificate only will be considered as authentic.
2. Candidates with foreign diplomas should see the EdCIL website for equivalence (<http://www.edcil.co.in>), and if required should obtain an equivalence certificate well in advance from the evaluation division of the AIU (website <http://www.aiuweb.org>).
3. In case any Board awards grades instead of marks, the calculation of equivalent marks would be based on the procedure prescribed by the Board.
4. **Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/central government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/ Biology as optional subjects individually. "However, the students possessing 10+2 qualification from non-formal and non-class rooms based schooling such as National Institute of Open Schooling, open school systems of States etc. shall not be eligible for admission to B.Pharm program."**
5. At the time of reporting for documents verification, candidates will be required to produce originals of Pass certificate & Marksheet of Class 10, Marksheet of Class 12 showing requisite minimum marks, as well as Caste or Special Category certificates in proper format signed by appropriate authority.
6. At any level of the studies [Class X or Class XII], a candidate / applicant must have passed all the required subjects at that level from the same Board.
