Guidelines for Physical Reporting of the applicants who have been allotted a seat for B.Tech., B.Arch. and Integrated M.Sc. Programs (BIT Mesra) through JoSAA/CSAB 2023

Date: 31st July 2023

We welcome all the selected students and their parents/guardian to BIT Mesra, who have been allotted a seat for admission to B.Tech., B.Arch. and Integrated M.Sc. Programs at Mesra campus through JoSAA/CSAB 2023.

Please note the following:

- The **physical reporting** activity will be carried out for the candidates who have secured their admission by paying the acceptance fees of JoSAA/CSAB 2023 **from 14**th **August to 21**st **August 2023 at BIT Mesra Campus**.
- Pay the balance Institute fee (for 1st semester), between 14th August to 21st August 2023, using Online Payment Gateway through debit / credit card and net banking of any nationalized bank, only after the successful document verification during physical reporting.

Note:

- 1. Candidates may deduct initial fee paid to JOSAA/CSAB 2023 from the total fee to be paid (except the processing fees paid to JoSAA/CSAB).
- 2. Institute Balance Fee payment (after Fee Payment done at JoSAA/ CSAB 2023 Counselling) needs to be done by the candidate. The Institute Balance Fee demand shall be reflected at the ERP Portal.
- 3. In addition to the above, students will also be required to pay mess advance at the time of joining the hostel.
- <u>ENROLLMENT NUMBERS</u>: Institute enrollment numbers will be issued to the students only after completion of document verification process and Institute Balance fee payment.

- <u>COURSE REGISTRATION FOR THE 1ST SEMESTER:</u> Every semester you need to register for the courses through our Institute ERP system. The same shall be done at the time of reporting.
- CLASSES: Classes will commence tentatively from first week of September 2023.

Documents required during verification

- 1. 2 passport size coloured photographs.
- 2. Printout of Seat Allotment Letter.
- 3. Photo ID proof as per Govt. India norms (In case of Photo on JEE Admit card not clear).
- 4. Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth and Name of Candidate.
- 5. Certificate and Marks sheet of qualifying examination 10+2 (Class XII).
- 6. Admit Card and Score card of JEE (Main) issued by NTA.
- 7. Proof of seat acceptance fee payment by Net Banking / Debit card / Credit card or State Bank of India e-challan
- 8. Medical Report in the format included as per specified Format (as per Annexure 7 of JoSAA Business Rules available on the JoSAA portal).
- 9. Certificate of category (SC/ST), if applicable, issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format available at JoSAA Portal.
- Certificate of category of GEN-EWS, if applicable, is to be issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format available at JoSAA Portal. The certificate must have been issued on or after 1stApril 2022.
- 11. Valid Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable (Format available at JoSAA Portal). The certificate should be issued from a duly constituted Medical Board. The certificate would be valid for a period of 5 years for those whose disability is temporary. For those who acquired permanent disability, the validity can be shown as permanent. Certificate not issued by a Medical Board or invalid / expired on the date of reporting shall not be accepted in any case. The minimum degree of disability should be 40% in order to be eligible for any concessions/benefits.
- 12. One set of self-attested copies of all the documents listed above.
- 13. Migration Certificate
- 14. School Leaving / Transfer Certificate from the college / school last attended.
- 15. Candidates are advised to keep enough attested copies of above documents / certificates for their future use.
- 16. Please make sure that email id and mobile number provided in JoSAA/ CSAB are functional and available with you at the time of physical reporting.
- 17. Filling and submission of Anti-Ragging affidavit is mandatory for all students and procedure for the same is provided below as Annexure-I.
- 18. Please carefully read the <u>Rules and Regulations</u> of the Institute and submit the signed Undertaking form available in Annexure III (hard copy in Legal page, shall be provided at the time of Physical Reporting).

Annexure - I

Procedure for submission of Anti-ragging Affidavit [during admission]

How can fill Online Affidavits and Why?

- 1. It is mandatory for every student and his/her parents to submit an anti-ragging affidavit at the time of admission. These are UGC's regulations.
- 2. It is the order of the Hon. Supreme Court that contact details of students must be collected from these affidavits and stored electronically at a central location.

It is a simple procedure comprising 3 Steps

Step 1: Log on to

www.ANTIRAGGING.in or www.AMANMOVEMENT.org

Click on the button called 'Online Affidavits'

Step 2: Fill in the information as desired and submit the form.

Step 3: On successful completion, you will receive affidavits, both for Students and Parents, through E-mail.

Note:

- If you do not have an E-mail address, please create one before you fill an affidavit forms.
- If your mother or father or guardian does not have a phone, or a mobile phone or email then please give the numbers / email of their friends or relations or neighbors.
- If you do not have a mobile number, then please give the mobile number of your friend in the Institute.

After filling this form successfully, you will receive the Student's Anti Ragging Affidavit and the Parents Anti Ragging Affidavit in your Email. Please print both the Affidavits, sign them yourself, request your parents to read the details and request them to sign their affidavit and then submit both to the Head of the Department of your allotted Department.
