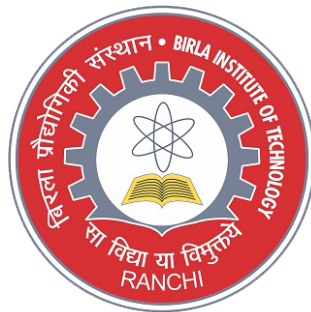

Sec 1: Introduction- Academic Programs of the Institute

Sec 2: How to Apply and Selection Procedures

How to Apply:

1. Interested and eligible candidates of the NRI / OCI / FS category, who wish to apply for admission to an academic program listed in Section 1, may apply online.
2. To fill online application form, click on the link “**APPLY ONLINE**” to register and create password for the application process. Do not share the password with anybody. [Please refer instructions for filling online application form.](#)
3. To apply for any program, eligible candidates must complete and submit the application through online only.
4. Pay the application fee of USD 250 (Non-refundable) through electronic transfer to Birla Institute of Technology, A/c No. **0063102000033901**, with IDBI Bank Ltd., Main Road, Ranchi, and Swift Code No. **IBKLINBB017** (Note: Please pay banking charges, if any).

Payment through DD will not be accepted.

5. Send the filled-in application form along with required documents [please refer required list of documents] by email as an attachment [including scan of receipt of electronics transfer] at admissions@bitmesra.ac.in.
6. Handwritten form will not be accepted.
7. Candidates are requested to go through the eligibility criteria, rules and regulations, details of fees, maintenance costs and other conditions given in this Brochure as well as on our website <http://www.bitmesra.ac.in> before submitting their applications.

Selection Procedures:

Upon receipt of filled-in application form along with required enclosures as an attachment by e-mail and if found eligible for admission, will be sent an offer letter for provisional admission by email as per the dates mentioned above, provided that the seat of choices sought are not yet filled (please refer important dates).

Undergraduate programs:

Provisional selections to B.Tech. B.Pharm., B.HMCT and Integrated M.Sc. programs will be based on percentage of marks obtained by the candidates in Class X and XI or equivalent examination (aggregate marks). In case of a tie, candidates will be decided based on marks obtained by the candidates in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry at Class X and XI level (aggregate).

The provisional selection of appearing candidates will be cancelled automatically, if candidate failed to submit the proof of passing the Class XII / equivalent examination with minimum 60% marks and Certificate of NRI / OCI / SFFS from the Competent Authority at the time of reporting for admission.

The provisional selection/offer letter with allocated seat/branch will be cancelled, if candidate failed to submit the first semester fee of USD 4500 on or before 15th June 2021. The allocated seat will be given to wait-listed candidates. **Fees once submitted are non-refundable in any case.**

Postgraduate programs:

Provisional selections to all postgraduate programs will be based on percentage of marks obtained by a candidate in Class X, XII and Graduation/Postgraduation. The Candidates should have minimum 60% marks throughout in Class X, XII and Graduation/ Postgraduation. Candidates appearing for qualifying examination (graduation / postgraduation) may also apply, subject to have minimum percentage of marks (above 60%) upto pre-final year of graduation/ postgraduation.

Note:

- Marks to be computed as per norms/policy of the respective Board / Authority conducting the examination.
- Upon receipt of the offer letter for provisional admission from our Office, candidates will be required to transfer of USD 250 towards admission fee [one-time non-refundable] to confirm the seat allotted to them.
- Candidates will also be required to deposit admission cum semester fee through electronic transfer through “SWIFT” before 15th June 2021.
- In the last week of July 2021 [“between 19-23 July 2021”], candidates along with father/mother in person are expected to produce the original application form along with all required documents in original for completing the admission process. [For the aforesaid purpose, it is advisable that the appointment may be sought for a date of earliest convenience].
- Fees once submitted are non-refundable.

5. Certificate(s) from competent authority [Embassy / consulate of India in the country of your residence] indicating that your parent is an NRI **OR** Passport / Citizenship document of any foreign country as proof of being OCI / SFFS
6. Certificate from the candidate's father / mother's employer stating the nature & duration of employment.
7. **Undertaking from parent that he/she will pay all the fees of the Institute in USD for the entire duration of the course, at the beginning of each semester during registration 1st week of July and 1st week of January every year until completion of the program.**
8. Copy of passport
9. Copy of parent's passport
10. Recommendation letter

PG Programs:

1. Receipt of electronic transfer of USD 250 (non-refundable) in favour of “Birla Institute of Technology”, towards Application Fee.
2. Pass certificate of Class X / High School Certificate or other document as proof of age.
3. Marksheets of Class X, XII and Graduation / Postgraduation (as applicable), indicating clearly that you have obtained requisite minimum marks in aggregate in each examination.
4. Certificate of qualifying examination - Graduation / Postgraduation.
5. College Leaving Certificate and Migration Certificate
6. Certificate(s) from competent authority [Embassy / consulate of India in the country of your residence] indicating that your parent is an NRI **OR** Passport / Citizenship document of any foreign country as proof of being OCI / SFFS
7. Certificate from the candidate's father / mother's employer stating the nature & duration of employment
8. **Undertaking from parent that he/she will pay all the fees of the Institute in USD for the entire duration of the course, at the beginning of each semester during registration 1st week of July and 1st week of January every year until completion of the program.**
9. Copy of passport
10. Copy of parent's passport
11. Recommendation Letter
12. Candidates who have appeared /are appearing for the final examinations of their qualifying degree in 2021 can also apply, provided that they have obtained requisite marks, as given in the eligibility criteria, based on latest available grades / marks at the time of applying. They must enclose copies of Marksheets upto pre-final year/semester. They must also enclose photocopies of a certificate from the Principal of Institute stating that:
 - a) the date when he / she has appeared for examination in all subjects required for obtaining their qualifying degree.
 - b) He /she has obtained requisite marks based on latest available grades / marks. Marks to be calculated as in eligibility criteria.

Note [For applicants of both UG (after class XII or equivalent) and PG programs]

13. Candidates who have appeared / appearing for the final examinations of their qualifying degree in 2021 may send their applications in advance, but a copy of their final result must be mailed immediately on publication or latest by 30th June 2021. If a candidate is unable to submit marksheet of qualifying examination by above date, provisional offer of admission may still be granted, provided he/she is otherwise found suitable for a program. **However, in such a case, proof of passing the qualifying examination with requisite marks must then be provided at the time of admission, failing which the provisional admission will be withdrawn / cancelled.**
14. Candidates will also be required to submit a written undertaking that all the certificates / documents submitted by them are authentic and are issued by competent authority and if at any stage during the program found not to be eligible for admission their admission shall be cancelled.
15. **Please do not send any original certificates / documents by post / courier. Bring all above-mentioned original certificates / documents at the time of admission.**

Sec 4: Who Can Apply?

- Non-Resident Indians [NRI]
- Overseas Citizen of India [OCI]
- Foreign Nationals [Foreign Students]

In addition to the minimum educational qualifications as prescribed for each program, a candidate seeking admission under this category of admission must fulfill the following conditions:

1. The candidate must be Son or Daughter of NRI / OCI / Foreign Students

OR

2. The candidate must be citizen of a foreign land holding a valid passport issued by that country. These candidates shall pay prescribed fee in USD or equivalent.

OR

3. The candidate must have a duly valid certificate indicating OCI / Foreign Student status issued by a competent authority.

Proficiency in English is required.

Notes:

1. Candidates with foreign diplomas should see the Ed.CIL website for equivalence (<http://www.edcil.co.in>), and if required should obtain an equivalence certificate **well in advance** from the evaluation division of the AIU (website <http://www.aiuweb.org>).
2. In case any Board awards grades instead of marks at the Class X / XI / XII level, the calculation of equivalent marks would be based on the procedure prescribed by the Board.
3. In case any University awards grades instead of marks at the graduate/postgraduate level, the calculation of equivalent marks would be based on the procedure prescribed by the Board / University.
4. In case a University does not have any scheme for converting CGPA into equivalent marks, the equivalence would be established by dividing obtained CGPA with the maximum possible CGPA and multiplying the result with 100.

Sec 5: Eligibility Criteria for Undergraduate Programs

Common Minimum Eligibility Criteria for all Undergraduate Programs (CMEC-UG)

- a) Only those candidates whose date of birth falls on or after 1 October 1996 are eligible for admission. [Date of Birth as recorded in the Secondary Education Board Class X (High School) certificate or equivalent only will be considered as authentic].
- b) Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks in Class X or equivalent examination.
- c) Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks in Class XI or equivalent examination.
- d) Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks in Class XII / QE (Equivalent Qualifying Examination). [Total Marks / Average / GPA in Class XII to be computed as per the respective Boards/ authority conducting the examination]
- e) Candidates for some programs must have studied and passed certain required subjects / combinations of subjects in **Class XII** as given below.

S.No	Program	Other Eligibility Criteria in addition to the Common Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Undergraduate Programs (CMEC-UG) given above
1	B.Tech.	Candidates must have passed in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics in Class XII / I.Sc. or equivalent examination, with minimum 60% marks (average of five subjects PCM + Eng + Anyone).
2	B.Pharm.	Candidates must have passed in Physics, Chemistry and in any one of: Mathematics / Biology / Biotechnology in Class XII / I. Sc. or equivalent examination with minimum 60% marks.
3	BHMCT	Candidates must have passed in English in Class XII / Intermediate or equivalent examination with minimum 60% marks.

Please also Note:

1. In case a Board/ authority only indicates Grades:
Minimum average of Grade "C" / Minimum average Grade point of "4" in PCM / PCB in standard XII or Equivalent Degree, whatever the case may be, the grade point must be equivalent to 60%. [Equivalent marks proof to be produced by the applicant]
2. Candidates are advise to visit Ed.CIL website for equivalence (<http://www.edcil.co.in>), and if required should obtain an equivalence certificate well in advance from the evaluation division of the AIU (website <http://www.aiuweb.org>).

Sec 6: Eligibility Criteria for Postgraduate Programs

6A) Common minimum eligibility criteria for MBA, MCA, and M.Sc. programs

- a) Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks in average of all subjects in Class X or equivalent examination.
- b) Candidates must have passed with minimum 60% marks in Class XII / Equivalent Examination. **[For MCA program: The candidates must have passed in Mathematics / Computer Science / Information Practices as one of the subject in Class XII / Equivalent Examination].**
- c) Candidates must hold a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent qualification of any of the Universities incorporated by an act of the Central or State Legislatures in India or other educational institutions established by an act of Parliament or declared to be Deemed as a University under section 3 of UGC Act, 1956, or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India / AIU. This degree must entail a minimum of three years of education after completing higher secondary schooling [Class XII or equivalent] (10+2+3 system).
- d) Candidates of B.Sc. / B.A. / B.Com. Honours must have minimum 60% marks in average in their Honours subject. Candidates of Bachelor of Computer Applications / other graduate courses must have minimum 60% marks in average in graduation.

Campus Facilities

The well-appointed campus facilities at BIT Mesra serve the manifold needs of BIT community life. It is accepted here that exploring the full potential of student life needs to incorporate parallel methods of learning with provision for complete self-expression.

BIT Mesra is a fully residential campus, providing accommodation to approx. 3200 undergraduate and postgraduate students and 2000 members of the faculty and staff. The main building accommodates lecture halls, research and training laboratories, library, administrative offices etc. covering an area of 30,000 sq. mtrs while the workshop annexure has a covered area of 4,000 sq. mtrs. The laboratories and offices of the Department of Space Engineering & Rocketry comprise a sub-campus that is some distance away from the main building for reasons of security.

The campus has vast expanse of green dotted with facilities for cultural, recreational and sports activities. The campus is in every sense a melting pot for diverse interests, influences and cultures that blend to create the unique strength that represents BIT Mesra.

Residential Campus

The Institute is completely residential with eleven hostels for boys and three separate ones for girls. All student lodging houses are spacious and beautifully laid out amidst a lot greenery.

Each male-student is provided with well-furnished single-accommodation while girls share their accommodation in spacious and adequately furnished rooms. Individual rooms are constructed in a row with a wide veranda for common use running along the length of passage. Common facilities at the hostel include dining halls and common rooms with provision for several indoor games. The reading room in each hostel subscribes to a large number of magazines, periodicals and newspapers. The entertainment hall in each hostel has a colour television set. Each hostel has an independent mess, completely run and managed by the students themselves.

The hostels are a hub of leisure activities. Students are encouraged to pursue a wide range of extracurricular activities and hobbies in their free time and events both entertaining and competitive are arranged quite frequently. Inter-hostel tournaments of indoor and outdoor games, quizzes, competitions and adventure trips are very popular at BIT Mesra.

The 'Hostel Night' organized by resident students is a memorable yearly event where students interact with the faculty members amidst cultural programs and a lot of fun in a shared mood of festivity.

Other Facilities at the BIT Campus

In addition to on-campus hostel arrangements, students have access to plenty of facilities for learning, recreation as well as sports activities within the grounds of BIT Mesra. The stately campus is self-contained in every sense with well-thought out provisions appointed for every need of the campus residents, be it the students, faculty or other staff members.

Facilities include two auditoriums that can accommodate as many as 2,500 people. This is an ideal venue for cultural events organized by the student community. The Institute has a well-appointed Gymnasium, indoor game facilities and extensive playgrounds for pursuing various outdoor sports. The campus also has two canteens and several other eating options within the premises. As young people mostly prefer to hang out in groups, all the campus eateries are very popular gathering zones. In addition, the Institute maintains three Guest Houses for accommodating guests appropriately.

The Campus has a Shopping Complex and consists of the Co-operative Stores in addition to the stationery shop, tailoring units, cafeterias etc. These provide for the daily requirements of the campus of nearly 5,000 residents. The construction of a full-fledged Marketing Complex and Cooperative Book Store to meet the growing needs of the Campus has recently been completed. Apart from this, the campus also houses a railway reservation counter and post office for the benefit of the residents.

Significant is the on-campus dispensary that provides for several diagnostic procedures and preventive & curative treatments. Emergency cases that require more specialist attention in intensive care facilities are referred either to the local Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences, Ranchi or to Apollo Hospital Erba, also in Ranchi. A Doctor from the campus Health Centre accompanies the patient in case of an emergency. The Institute maintains a liaison with the doctors of these two hospitals. The campus Dispensary-cum-Health Centre also provides free treatment and supply of medicines to residents of local villages in the region.

Sec 10: Discipline, Rules & Regulations, Hostel and Medical Examination

Institute Rules & Regulations: For details of Institute rules and regulations, please see booklet provided at the time of admission.

Discipline

The Institute places a very high emphasis on discipline of students both inside and outside the campus. Students must abide by the Institute and Hostel rules and agree to conform to the rules and regulations enforced from time to time. They must not do anything either inside or outside the Institute that will interfere with its orderly governance, discipline and image. Students must attend lectures, tutorials and practical classes regularly. A minimum attendance of 75% in lectures, tutorials and sessionals for each subject is essential for appearing in the Semester Examinations. Thus, students should attend all theory and laboratory classes from the first day of the academic year. In case of absence due to unavoidable circumstances, students are advised to take prior permission from the Dean / Head. In case of absence due to illness, students will have to produce a Medical Certificate with an application from their parents or guardians. In such a case, parents/guardians or Hostel Warden should inform the authorities immediately. Students should strike a proper balance between extracurricular activities and academic requirements. A student's participation in extra-curricular activities should not be allowed to interfere in his/her academic schedule.

During teaching hours, the main lobby, the library, the corridors of the Institute and the area surrounding the Institute are to be observed as silence zones. Students must not cause any disturbance in these zones. Students must not indulge in any kind of misconduct or indiscipline or anti-social activities within or outside the campus. Students must not form a group causing any hindrance to the academic and administrative activities of the College. Those found doing so will be punished and strict disciplinary action will be taken by the authorities. Students shall not damage the property of the Institute. Cost of such damage will be recovered from students, parents/guardians of the students.

Students must always carry their Identity Card and produce it on request. In case of loss or damage of Identity Card, the concerned authorities should be informed immediately.

Students are not permitted to enter and use the laboratory / workshop / sports ground if they do not wear appropriate dress. For example, they should enter the laboratory only with apron, cap or mask as instructed. Students should park their cycles in an orderly manner at the cycle stands. Students should follow the rules of the Hostel Mess / Canteen. Students are advised to read the Notice Boards regularly.

Students are strictly prohibited from possessing or consuming spirits, tobacco products and narcotic drugs either within or outside the campus, and if found violating this will be rusticated immediately, without warning.

Ragging in any form inside or outside the campus is strictly prohibited by law. Any students found ragging other students will be summarily expelled from the Institute and dealt with as per the directive of Hon. Supreme Court/Hon. High Court.

Each student must read the “UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009” on the UGC website. Each student admitted to any of the Institute's programs must submit the two completed affidavits [one from candidate and one from parents] at the time of admission. [Please refer Sec-9 of this Information Brochure].

Hostel

Hostel facilities are provided at BIT Mesra. All students are required to reside in one of the Institute hostels, to which they are allotted and must take food along with other inmates of the hostel in the common mess. There are separate hostels for girls' students.

Medical

All selected students will be required to undergo medical examination by a Medical Officer of the Institute and their admission is subject to being found medically fit for the Program. Therefore, candidates, for their own satisfaction, are advised to get themselves examined by a registered medical practitioner.

The Institute at Mesra is located in a spacious green campus. There are small forests with a large number of trees - mostly sal trees which are native to Chotanagpur. These sal trees and a number of other trees and plants have their flowering season during mid-February to early April, and this sometimes leads to large pollen content in the air. It has been noted that some people who are allergic or susceptible to pollen from these sal trees / other plants may develop some health problems / breathing problems or their existing problems may be aggravated during these weeks, as also during some other months of the year when other plants flower. Thus, such candidates who are known to be sensitive or susceptible to pollen from trees or other plants are required to get allergy tests done / take advice from their physicians / a specialist before taking admission at Birla Institute of Technology, Mesra, Ranchi.
