# Method of Evaluation(Theory)

S.No.	Examination Type	Full Marks
1.	Quiz( Two each of 10 marks)	20
2.	Mid-Term Examination	25
3.	Teacher's Assessment	05
4.	End Term Examination	50
	<b>Total</b>	<b>100</b>

- 75% of attendance is compulsory for appearing in the Examination.
- In case of medical problems, submit medical certificate to subject teachers. 65% of attendance is compulsory in this case.

2.	End Evaluation(Quiz, Performance, Viva)	40

Each subject is having different credits(1,2 credits ).  
Scored marks is converted in Grade point.  
Grade point is multiplied with Credit.

# Different Methods of Evaluation

- **Quiz(Written Test) Mostly Objective- 20 Marks**
- **Two Quiz(10 marks each) –**
- First Quiz after one month of classes
- Second Quiz 15-20 days before end of classes.

# Different Methods of Evaluation

- **Mid Term Examination-**
- Conducted after 40-45 days of classes.
- Full Marks- 25.
- Questions from 2 ½ modules(half of the syllabus).
- Question paper contains 5 questions, each of 5 marks.
- All questions are compulsory.
- Duration of Examination- 2 hrs.

# Different Methods of Evaluation

- **Teacher's Assessment - 05 Marks**
- It may be on Attendance/Assignment/Presentation etc.
- Evaluation method is decided by the Subject Teacher

All questions are compulsory.
